Completion of this program will greatly improve the participant's knowledge of Materials and Operations Management; knowledge that can be used in the working environment. These practical courses are based on a solid body of know ledge that has evolved over the past century.

There is also one particular benefit that can be extremely helpful in the times we are living and that can make the difference in somebody's life. This benefit is called-

Unemployed Member Benefit Extension Program.

To participate in the program you will need to fill out a form that is available on the APICS Corporate website, meet the criteria and follow the instructions. The form must be signed by the member and approved by the member's chapter president. If, at the time of billing, the member is unemployed and actively seeking work within the APICS business sector, his/her membership may be extended for a six-month period at no cost. The member may apply for the extension through the local chapter, which must approve the request and waive the chapter dues assessment. If the member remains unemployed at the end of the extension period, he/she may apply for an additional extension. Total extensions will be limited to three for a total of 18 months membership without assessed fees.

I hope to see you at upcoming Chapter Professional Development Meetings, Tours or Education classes. We are also always looking for volunteers for our Board of Directors. This is another great opportunity to improve your skills.


